## **Nominations and Elections Notices**

**Nominations are now being accepted for the following positions:** Elections Committee (12 open positions)

**Term of Office:** The term of office for Elections Committee runs from July 1, 2018 until June 30, 2020.

**Eligibility for Elections Committee:** Candidates must be current, dues paying members of the Washington Teachers' Union and must submit a nominations petition signed by a minimum of 20 WTU members to be eligible.

**Deadline for Nominations:** Nomination Petitions must be signed by the candidate and submitted no later than close of business (5pm) Friday, January 25, 2019, to: Washington Teachers' Union c/o WTU Elections Committee, 1239 Pennsylvania Ave. SE, Washington, DC, 20003. Nomination Petitions are included with this notice.

## **ELECTION: Tuesday, February 12, 2019**

The election of the WTU Elections Committee will be held at the WTU membership meeting on February 12, 2019. The election will be held from 4:30 to 7pm at McKinley Technology High School, 151 T Street, NE, Washington, DC, 20002. All members in good standing are eligible to vote. The election will be conducted by secret ballot in accordance with the WTU Constitution. Ballots will be counted and the results announced by the Elections Committee after the February 12, 2019, meeting.

Please note: members of the Election Committee are not eligible to run for a WTU office while remaining a member of the Elections Committee.
