Term of Office:

The term of office for the President, General Vice President, Vice Presidents, Recording Secretary, Trustees, Executive Board members and Delegates to the Metropolitan Washington Council, AFL-CIO runs from July 1, 2019 until June 30, 2022. The term of office for Delegates to Maryland State and DC AFL-CIO runs through the Convention of Fall 2019. The term of office for the Elections Committee runs through June 30, 2021.

Eligibility for President, General Vice President, Treasurer, Vice President, Recording Secretary Trustee Board, Executive Board and Elections Committee: Candidates must be current District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) teachers and full-dues paying members of the Washington Teachers' Union, Local #6, AFT, AFL-CIO (WTU) and must submit a nominations petition signed by a minimum of twenty (20) full dues paying members in good standing with the WTU, to be eligible.

Eligibility for Delegate to the Metropolitan Washington Council, AFL-CIO and Delegate to the Maryland State and DC AFL-CIO: Candidates must be current DCPS teachers and full-dues paying members in good standing of the WTU to be eligible. A member may self-nominate or be nominated by a WTU member in good standing by submitting his/her name on a nominating petition by the deadline. Signatures from additional WTU members are not required.

Deadline for Nominations:

Nomination petitions must be signed by the candidate and submitted no later than close of business (5:00 PM) Tuesday, April 30, 2019 to the Washington Teachers' Union, Election Committee, Membership Department, 1239 Pennsylvania Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20003. **Nomination Petitions are included with this notice.**

ELECTION

The election of WTU Officers, Trustees, Executive Board, Elections Committee and Delegates will be conducted by mail ballot. The ballots will be mailed no later than May 28, 2019. Ballots will be opened and counted by an independent agency at a location to be determined.
